Dear TWF friends

June and July are traditionally the two busiest months for our Programme team because of our T.E.E.N. (Talent Empowerment Equality & Networking) Programme. TWF's T.E.E.N. Programme is a youth-led leadership and gender awareness programme that teaches participants the value of a diverse, inclusive society and equips them with the skills to challenge gender bias and discrimination both at home and in the broader community.

In June, we welcomed 36 new TEENs and 12 Big Brothers and Sisters to the sixth cycle of the Programme through a series of induction experiences including a 4-day camp in Wong Yi Chau Youth Camp in Sai Kung. Excitement levels seemed even higher than usual this year as TEENs and Big Brothers and Sisters bonded through physical activities and self-awareness exercises!

Meanwhile, throughout July, the TEENs and Big Brothers and Sisters from the fifth cycle of TEEN wrapped up their 12 months on the Programme by spending four days at CLSA. Programme participants were CLSA staff members from different departments including Compliance, Research, Production, Administration, Legal, IT and HR, who mentored the TEENs and Big Brothers and Sisters and shared with them stories about their own careers. CLSA staff also ran presentation skills and career planning workshops for the groups. On the last day, each group of Programme participants gave presentations in English (quite a challenge for many TEENs) on their experiences and what they learnt. As usual, they were very appreciative of the warmth with which they were received at CLSA and the exposure to the workings of a leading global financial institution.

At TWF, we are similarly very grateful to CLSA for their support for the Programme over the last six years and would like to pay tribute to the many CLSA staff volunteers who have wholeheartedly supported the planning, design and implementation of the Programme from the curriculum design to the selection of training partners, to PR and media engagement, and working with individual TEENs and Big Brothers and Sisters.
